• **Discipleship:** Added a new WednesdayPM bible class & Cathy's Chronological lessons with the Deaf are still all-day-long! Also, 2 new men visitors are requesting Chronological Bible Lessons too. Summer is so busy here with folks working in their dachas (country gardens), that few remain in town making the streets rather empty & the pews somewhat bare, but praise Jesus for those who remain and hunger for Him.

We barely await when we can have a quiet, holy sanctuary where folks can come & hear the Word preached, where prayers are not drowned out by the vile Strip Bar/Club next to our room and visitors would be at liberty to stay/return. Thank you all for your prayers on my behalf in regards to my neck injury. I know when our prayer letter was received by you all because that is when a miraculas thing happened, after many long months in a neck brace, I am now able to walk around without the aid of the brace. Glory! I still have a lot of severe pain from the nerve but I'm doing a lot better. Thank you! Our little church has gone through a pruning season and like a tree it never looks good when it's all peared back but the Lord is faithful and He knows what he is doing. Now that spring is here we see Him producing new shoots & branches and we thank Him so much. He has added a new lady to our deaf ministry, her name is Olya. She is 27. She was saved several years ago in a different city but has been starving for five years here without a church to feed her spiritually. She is now taking individual Bible lessons along with Tanya (40), my other deaf student. God has placed me in the position of 'deaf translator' for the church for the time being. It's very challenging but I am enjoying every minute of it. The Lord has also added several new visitors, men, (Igor, Sasha, Andrei) who are now taking individual Bible lessons as well. Plans are in the making for our first ever Youth Camp this July. Brother Aubry Mapp will be coming over to preach this camp. We are using baseball as our big attraction for the camp. This came after our family was playing baseball in the park recently & a huge crowd gathered to watch. Then the kids were playing at another park & had a huge group of teens amass asking to touch the bat, ball & glove. The kids here (and some men even) are just fascinated with the game. So for the camp we will end each day with a baseball game (following some instruction). The theme for the camp will be "Who is on the Lord's Side?" Please be praying over

that, especially the necessary equipment. We had found a piece of property for sale we wished to buy to build a church on but it sold before we could get an email off to the States to raise up any money. Then after looking around & not finding anything else the Lord allowed this property to fall through & be put back up for sale. After prayer & some counsel we decided to seek the Lord's will in acquiring this land. If all goes well we will be building soon & away from the terrible location we are forced to meet at for this present time. Please pray with us to this end.
