PRAISES: After 7 years, one of the twin sons of Alla, our eldest church member, was finally saved! Yura has been struggling with the Spirit over his soul's condition and in Nov he finally repented, saying "Now I see Jesus as my only hope of Heaven." The change has been immediate & immense! We sent him along with John-Steven to the Faithful Men's Conference down in Crimea for 3 solid days of preaching & fellowship. **Pictured right**: Zhenya was anointed in church before being sent by our church to Odessa to a specialty eye clinic for surgery. Hallelujah her sight has been spared and Jesus reigns! She has been such a faithful witness & testimony. The operation was a great expense to us, but we are convinced that it was the absolute right thing to do. Since then, she's been a witnessing fireball at school! **PRAYERS:** Though the Lord quickly gathered many deaf back together (we broke attendance record), the Devil used 1 deaf lady to pull out all but 3. Please pray her repentance & that the Lord will help us





gather more Ukrainian deaf. *Church building: Pray for all the documents to get approved for the building, as costs are totally skyrocketing, so we can start construction this Spring '08. Adjoining property: We remain about \$8,000 short from pledged to actual received monies to buy the adjacent property to us. This is a necessary step, especially in the government's eyes, so as to provide sufficient area for the new building. We are needing to wrap that up as quickly as possible to assist in the final approval of all the plans at the City Architect. We are planning on a group of believers from Moldova to come Summer '08 to do much of the block work and are hoping some good men from the States will likewise come this summer and be strategic helpers as the Lord would provide. Please pray!

*** New Bible Lessons: As new small groups are formed, we need the Lord's presence & power. We are greatly praying for a new ministry opportunity in a village about 1 hour from the church. Pray for us.




