Joshua 1:8-11 On February 26th we received our new RELIGIOUS visas to work in KHARKOV, Ukraine and crossed over our JORDAN! We thank God above for bringing it to pass. Truly it was by His hand and counsel, Eccl. 10:4. We received six month visas. The religious officials said it is a "trial" period. Our next visa, they said, will be for one year. Please pray over us that they can find nothing to accuse us of during this period. We are focused on the work of the ministry and are trusting in God to watch our backs. We've spent a lot of time & money putting things in place to protect ourselves against another attack in the future. We are the wiser in the end, praise God. Our services have resumed and are growing in spirit and number. 18 in church, 12 in children's church. It is a precious time here with everyone rejoicing in this victory and OPENLY celebrating their faith again. Four folks are taking Bible lessons from John individually and we are searching for an indoor pool to baptize in next month. Things are in full swing with evangelism on Saturdays again. How great freedom is to have the legal right to evangelize! We can not thank you all enough for your prayers and hanging in there with us. Progress: My sign language lessons are going great, I have completed my book and am now going thru review. I am really excited about working with the deaf. The Lord has raised up the need of four hearing aids from the US that should arrive this summer. Please pray for our deaf, they need

discipleship on a slower and more indepth pace then others due to the language barrier they have: written language, even Russian, is extremely difficult for them to understand, and that includes the BIBLE! Language: My tongue is most rebellious towards these Russian diphthongs(!) although I am trying to allow the Lord to accomplish this through many hours of study, study, study and practice, practice, practice. It is my desire to be able to teach without a language translator by the end of 2003 but this will take God's help in doing. Praises: Lina, our first church member, is expecting to add to our church family in August with our first baby in the church. 1 Sam. 1:27! Rejoice with us in what God has done: opening Kharkov back up for the gospel's sake, & may fruit abound
