The Lord has blessed our way exceeding abundantly above all that we could ask or think: while preaching at Gateway Baptist in Las Vegas 3 precious souls came to Jesus for salvation; while at Shining Light BC in Tucson a young soldier in the Army accepted Christ and another young man at Baptist Temple in Ft. Worth came forward to be saved too. AMEN! All the miles were well worth it! **PRAISES**: "Worthy is the Lamb that was slain" they cried in Rev 5. Christ surely is worthy of all we have to give. • Kharkov: Sickness & city-wide quarantines have marked the new year in Kharkov, trying to hinder the fruit of Faith Bible Baptist's ministries. A church teen fell on the ice breaking her arm after a Sunday service but was back on Wednesday with her new cast. The Mission work in the village is growing with new inquirers & contacts. Sasha is leading the core group well which grows thru these testing times & they are all preparing for the coming Passover in April. This is our largest service of the year & again we will have members travel up to 25 hours via train to come. • Ministry: More than 5,000 pieces of Gospel literature were printed & distributed in these 2 months, even though February dropped to -20 in Kharkov. Home Bible studies flourish during the cold & will produce fruit in the Spring. FURLOUGH: January-February brought us to 20 churches in AZ, FL, NV, TX, LA, MS, TN & KY, 6 of which were prospective new supporters for the ministries in Kharkov! We've been so blessed by our supporting churches, seeing both the old & the new folks in each church. Praise Jesus for such loving "fellow helpers to the truth (3Jn 8). Some have just overwhelmed us with their outpouring of love & appreciation towards us, it so humbles us by it all. PRAYER REQUESTS: "Ye have not because ye ask not" - Jesus.
