
O'Brien's Prayers & News

Eze 33:7 "I have set thee a watchman unto (Ukraine); therefore thou shalt hear the word at My mouth, and warn them from Me." Our Sunday School began it's Watchman Marathon after weeks of preparation. Each Teen was paired with an adult member of the church. The teams' assignments were to hold person-to-person contacts in giving a sinner the gospel. The unsaved soul was asked specific questions & were to write down to record WHAT it is that they understood thru this witness. Our goal was to be faithful witnesses - Watchmen, able to stand before God as Paul did & say by the end of the Marathon "I am pure from the blood of all men." The salvation of the souls we were leaving entirely up to God who alone must give the increase. We did not want the teams racing to get professions out of people just for the Marathon who might not truly understand the gospel. So points were only giving for witnessing, but not for any resulting professions. That way, if a salvation did result, we could be sure it was a true profession produced from conviction by God's Word and not any other reason. The teams went out every Saturday, some of them even met on Friday nights to go over Bible verses & practice witnessing. Immediately the Lord showed His hand upon it. Our first day out two souls repented before God calling upon Christ for salvation after hearing the gospel! As each week progressed, many friends & neighbors of our church members were hearing the gospel for the first time. By the end of the Marathon, 178 recorded person-to-person gospel witnesses had been given to souls in our city! As we did our part in giving the gospel, God

was faithful to bring the increase as the following souls repented of their sins turning to Christ by faith for salvation: Valeria (Mar 11), Ludmila (Mar 11), Irina (Mar 18), Ekaterina (Mar18), Larissa (Mar 18), Lidia (Mar 25), Evgenia (Apr 1), Yuri (Apr 29), Zoya (Apr 29), Elena (Apr 29). Others recorded that they understood the gospel and believed in it but were unclear whether or not they were actually making a sincere decision to accept Christ. So we will be following up on these: Tolataya, Arthur, Natalia, Evgenii, Irina, Lubov. Please pray as we disciple these new believers & as we visit again those who are on the edge of salvation. Special note: Evgenia was the young lady who almost died in the car wreck last year! CONGRATULATIONS! Our eldest daughter Brittaini turned 18 May 6th and graduated on May 19. We were blessed to have 3 BIMI missionary families travel to Kharkov to participate in her commencement ceremony. Well done, Brit! *Cathy*
