March also brought John-Steven's 20th birthday and April brought Kendon's 18th birthday and his driver's license too, which he received while visiting grandparents in Tucson after the court case. It's been great having such godly children & watching them grow up strong in the spirit, filled with wisdom, & seeing the grace of God upon them as they serve Him both here & in College.
