March - Between doctors visits & tests, I was able to visit supporting churches & help Sergei gather needed support for his ministry in Ukraine including a flight to Texas which the Lord greatly blessed Neurosurgeon! God has given me a specialist **surgeon** who agreed to immediately perform my neck surgery, replacing a bad disk with a new prosthetic one so not to lose any range of motion! Cathy arrived super late the night before my surgery and was so grateful to have her by my side. The surgery was very successful and I now have far less nervous system issues, though not completely resolved. April - Recovery process begins and we saw the Lord immediately intervene when while we were in Georgia both Cathy & I **slipped** & fell on dimly lit stairs at a church. In extreme pain we immediately went to the ER for scans and then a 10hr trip home to Charlotte to meet my neurosurgeon the following Monday for more scans. Verdict? Nothing damaged! Miracle! He even cleared me to leave for Ukraine. So we began the process of packing & preparing to return home to Kharkov finally. We spent our final Sunday at our home church and said all of our "Goodbyes" to so many. Cathy then left for Arizona to visit her family while I returned to Kharkov to begin submitting documents for our annual Religious **Visa** renewal. Please pray for this process, for approvals and the continued work which the Lord has given us here. The **war** continues inching closer & closer daily. Though I can't pick up anything until July 1st, I've been able to continue Bible Lessons with refugees and church members, visiting shut-ins and starting to get the church property back in shape after a long difficult Ukrainian winter. Please pray for the needed **finances** for all that has transpired: travel, lodging, living, medical expense especially. May the Lord bless & recompense unto each who keeps us before His throne of grace, and for those who give so sacrificially to help us here in our needs.

The past 3 months have been extremely challenging financially on us personally and in the ministry, including finally getting the wrecked Hilux repaired, airline tickets & travel \$6k as well as numerous medical expenses which are still rolling in, which is the burden we bear not having had access to quality healthcare for 26 years here in Ukraine. The costs of being Stateside for travel & lodging & living expenses, combined with maintaining the ministries in Ukraine far exceed our ability alone to cover. We needed to ship 5 bags of supplies back to Ukraine including medicines & items which we can't get here. That comes in around \$700.
