Now that we are all back in Ukraine we are once again realizing that we are "not in Kansas anymore", enduring through the numerous readjustments of the "norm" of being here. The church's warm welcome was wonderful and each in their own way have expressed their heart gratitude regarding our finally returning 'home' to Ukraine. What a blessing when your church folks say that you are "home" when you are here with them. Please pray with us as we do undergo these adjustments and inconveniences, ranging from sporadic water supplies at home and frequent loss of electrical power to the absolute anarchic chaos of the Ukrainian drivers and the roads which are fit only for tanks & airplanes (so say the Ukrainians!). Regardless of the sacrifices, we are forever grateful that the Lord would use us here for HIS eternal glory! PRAISES: "Thou art worthy ... for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood" (Rev 5:9)

KHARKOV: "Be thou diligent to know the state of thy flocks" we are told in Prov 27:23, and this is exactly what we are spending much time doing. Furloughs are extremely tough on the mission works and the toll which our first full furlough has taken on the believers here is evident in many areas. We see a 6-12 month period of regrouping, rekindling and reviving with much inhome person-to-person ministering. We rejoice with those who stood the whole time and our hearts are heavy over those who couldn't keep their heads above water in our long absence. This is especially true in the Teens, with the Youth Group down to but a few. Bro Sasha and the core group did a valiant job in our absence, but they too are utterly exhausted and enjoying the rest. TRACTS: By the end of October, we had already distributed over **10,000** pieces of Gospel literature and have visited dozens of homes. We have had some sweet after-evangelism fellowships and have seen the Spirit of the Lord begin to awaken many.

• Souls Saved: During our regular Saturday Evangelism, we have seen a few teen boys come to Christ. With so much of the Word's seed being sown here, we hope to see some more harvesting of precious Ukrainian souls for the glory of our Lord Jesus. That's why we're here!! ◆ Harvest Day: We were blessed to have an all-time record attendance of "first time" visitors at our Harvest Day BBQ & Fellowship. I cooked 'shashleek', a famous BBQ dish here, and used the cooking time to witness to our visitors.
