A special thanks to all who laboured to serve while we were back in Arizona: great will be your reward. We got the rest we needed and saw 7 adults come to salvation our last week.

She has been receiving chronological Bible lessons for ten months now but has resisted the conviction of the Holy Spirit. Luda was stumped as to why so when we returned we invited them over for dinner & to get an update from Larissa about some of the events that our deaf people have been part of while we were gone. This led to a quiet time of relaxed talking & provided the atmosphere to approach her about her lack of salvation. After discussing it with her for a while we were able to conclude that she had a confused idea about what was involved with "repentance". The Baptist Union here preaches it as a necessary work of the flesh, the public confessing of sins before man and God, to obtain the mercy of God for salvation. Larissa said she just couldn't bring herself to shame herself publicly with speaking of all her sins. Praise the Lord that He revealed her need. John took Larissa through the message of the scriptures again showing her that no public

display & confession to man was part of God's true plan of salvation. Then she said it sounded too easy. More scriptures read. She desired to be saved but still hesitated.
